This collection represents the life work of Gene Wright, history professor.



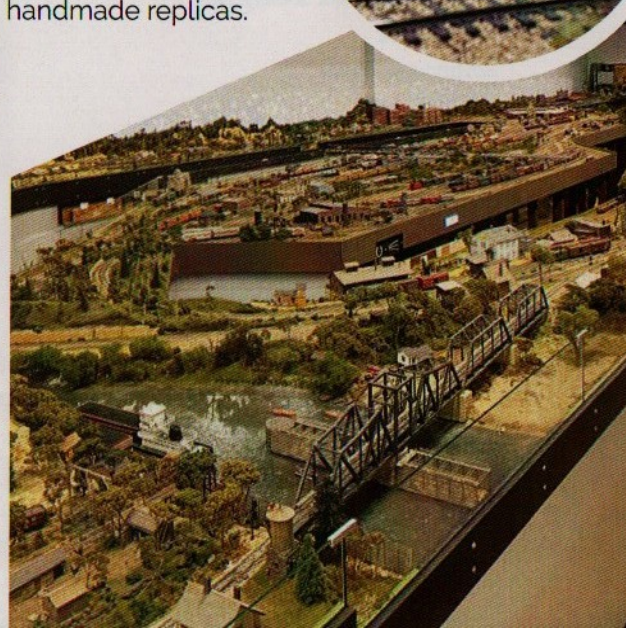
